The Frankton High School History Honor Society, a subsidiary of the National History Scholars Society and the Frankton History Club, would like to cordially congratulate you upon your position as a potential member of this prestigious group.

The Frankton High School History Honor Society was formed in recognition of students who have embraced their role as “apprentice historians”. This honor society is the first in the state of Indiana to receive a charter granted through the National History Club and the National History Scholars Society. The faculty of the Social Studies department wishes to recognize students who have shown academic success within History offerings and interest in the field. To be considered for membership students must meet the following requisites:

- Be at least a junior in good academic standing at the time of their consideration;
- Have completed at least three semesters of course offerings within the department;
- Have completed at least one semester of an Advanced Placement offering within the department with a semester grade of at least 80 percent;
- Demonstrate an overall grade point average of at least 3.3;
- Demonstrate a department specific grade point average of at least 3.5;
- Have participated for at least one full year as an active member of the Frankton History Club.

The criteria listed above reflect the minimum requirements for membership. You have been recognized as meeting these minimum requirements. The final criteria to be considered will be a short response to the following question: “What inspires you about the study of history?” The deadline for this response is: February 10, 2010.

The final decision for all members will be made by a majority decision of the entire Social Studies department. New members will be welcomed at a ceremony scheduled for a later date.
